Title: Five is one too many – observations on two breeding pairs of the Common Swift S. Meyer, Laufen, Switzerland

Common Swifts are believed to return to the nestbox which they occupied the year before. But what if there is already another bird present? Or even a breeding pair with nestlings in this nestbox? And then the intruder wins the fight? This happened in one nestbox in Switzerland in 2020. How does such a takeover affect the partner's behaviour? Or the fledging success of the chicks?

This presentation is a review of this previously unknown situation in two Common Swift families recorded using a camera inside the nestboxes.
